

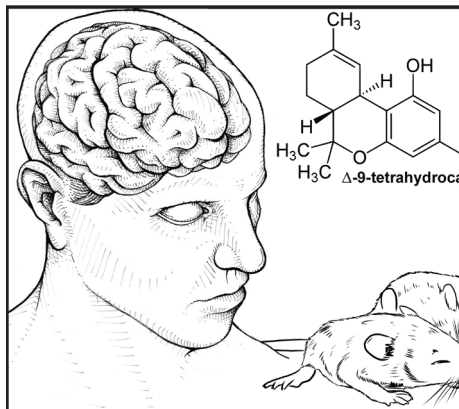

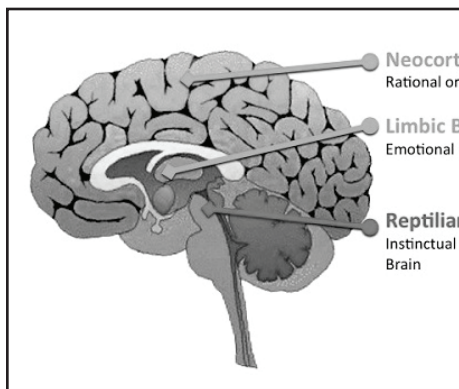

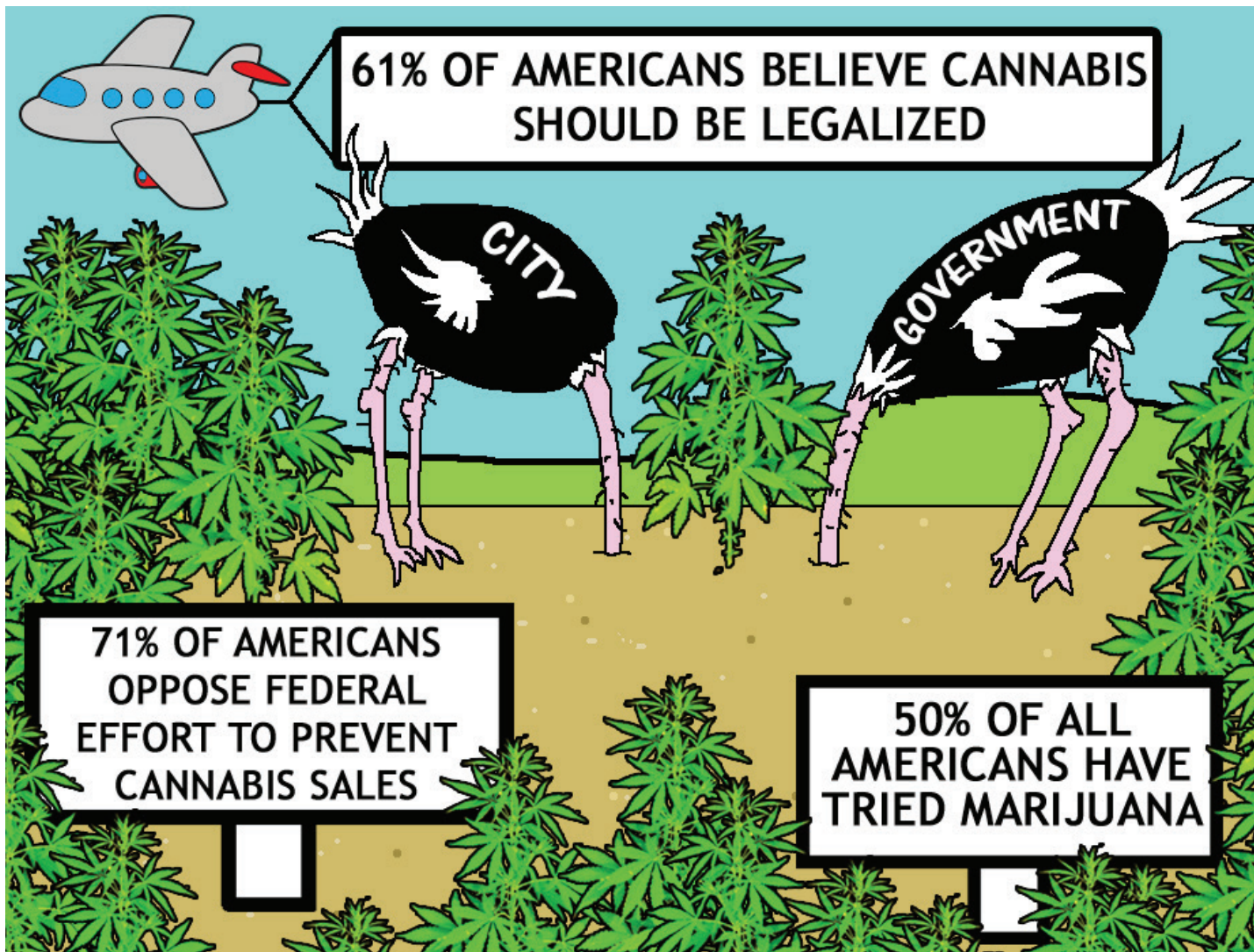

The Chula Vista City Council Ostrich

The city of Chula Vista has unanimously voted to ban all marijuana dispensaries medical and recreational. The council doesn't feel like they have had enough time to come up with regulations, which is odd seeing medical marijuana has been approved in the state of California since 1996. This leaves most citizens to question how much more time they need? One resident stood up and addressed the city council comparing them to Ostriches, sticking their heads in the sand to ignore what's going on.

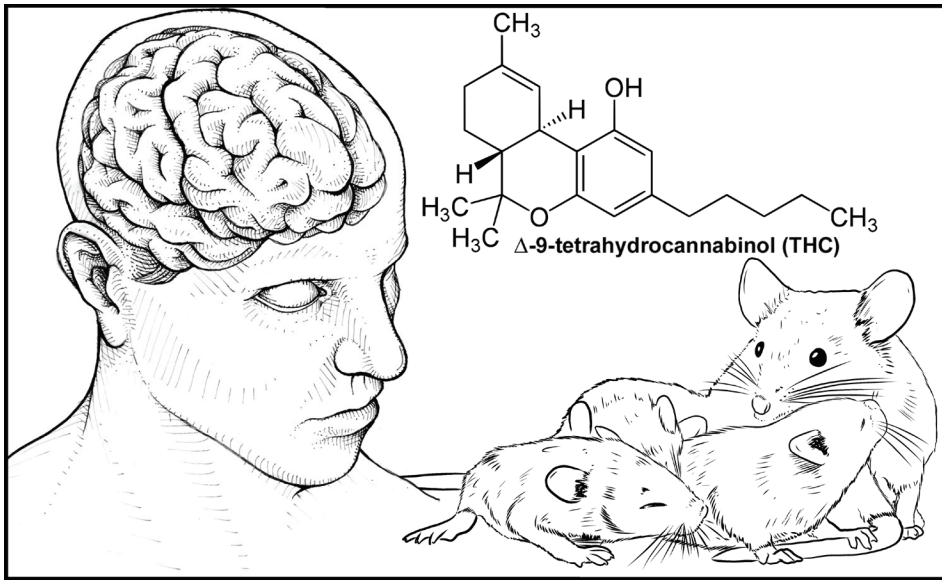
The city for now, will not have any approved dispensaries until they come up with a long term policy on the collectives. One of the members did stress at the close of the meeting that they do just see this as being temporary and they will address the issue at a future date.

The other cannabis related item on the agenda had addressed adding marijuana and other controlled substances to their social host ordinance. The social host ordinance is by definition, a legal term of the law that deals with the liability of a person who supplies liquor to a guest under the legal age. Under current social host ordinance laws, the host shares any liability incurred as a result of actions by an intoxicated guest to whom he or she has served liquor.

The city says they will be cracking down on the social host ordinance holding adults responsible for providing access to minors. Chula Vista Police Captain Lon Turner was quoted by CBS 8 as saying these parties have date rapes happening and all kinds of other disorderly behavior. If the city adds marijuana to the proposed social host ordinance it would read like this

"It is the duty of any person having control of any premises, who knowingly hosts, permits, or allows a gathering at said premises to take all reasonable steps to prevent the consumption of alcoholic beverages, marijuana, or other controlled substances by any minor at the gathering."





THC as a Dementia Treatment

Smoking pot kills brain cells and makes you dumb. It's a common cliché that stems from the way people can behave while under cannabis' psychoactive effects; but the idea's validity has been up for debate. The plant has many medicinal uses, though the idea of using it for cognitive improvement hasn't been one of the more common ones. People have long spoken about being able to focus better after smoking marijuana, but until recent years, there has not been a great deal of hard information on the subject. We are entering a new era of cannabis legalization, and real scientific studies are starting to debunk, support, or elaborate on current conclusions that are based solely on anecdotal evidence. While peoples' real experiences and personal accounts have merit, reviewable data from documented research by qualified professionals with access to modern facilities is invaluable. Scientific results have a greater potential to influence public opinion and marijuana law reform.

Early this month, researchers at the University of Bonn in western Germany, and the Hebrew University of Jerusalem released the results of a collaborative study that shows that small doses of tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) could have cognitive benefits for the elderly. Data from the study also suggests that the cannabinoid may not be beneficial for younger brains.

Researchers separated mice into young (two months), mature/middle-aged (12 months), and elderly (18 months) age groups. After the administration of low doses of THC, researchers tested the mice to see how fast they could navigate a water maze puzzle and recognize familiar objects. THC hindered the performance of the younger mice in the study, but the same dosage in the older mice improved their cognitive function. As a mouse ages, the amount of genetic activity in its brain will change. After being given THC for four weeks, genes in the brains of the older rodents returned to activity levels of those seen in two-month-old mice. Contrarily-wise, when researchers ad-

ministered THC to the two-month-old mice, the genes behaved like those of the untreated elderly mice.

Study leader, Dr. Andras Bilkei-Gorzo explains that "Giving THC artificially activates the system in the old [mice]. It can restore signaling to a normal level. If you do the very same treatment, with the same dosage, to young mice, you overdrive the whole system, as it's at a much higher level than it should be."

THC and its anti-inflammatory properties may be partly responsible for the mental improvement in the elderly mice as well. Inflammation is one the body's injury response methods where it deploys white blood cells (macrophages, leukocytes) and cytokines (signaling proteins) in an attempt to fight off an infection from a foreign invader. THC is an anti-inflammatory cannabinoid that uses a process called apoptosis, which suppresses cytokine production. While it is a necessary function of the human immune system, prolonged inflammation can cause tissue damage. There is increasing evidence that neuroinflammation has a positive association with neurodegeneration, impaired neurogenesis, and increased risk of dementia.

While researchers say that they need to conduct more trials, they are encouraged by the results of the new study and hope that they can find a treatment for dementia in cannabis. They write in the journal that, "These results reveal a profound, long-lasting improvement of cognitive performance resulting from a low dose of THC treatment in mature and old animals." The research group is now looking at conducting a small-scale study later this year involving human test subjects who are between 60 and 70 years of age.

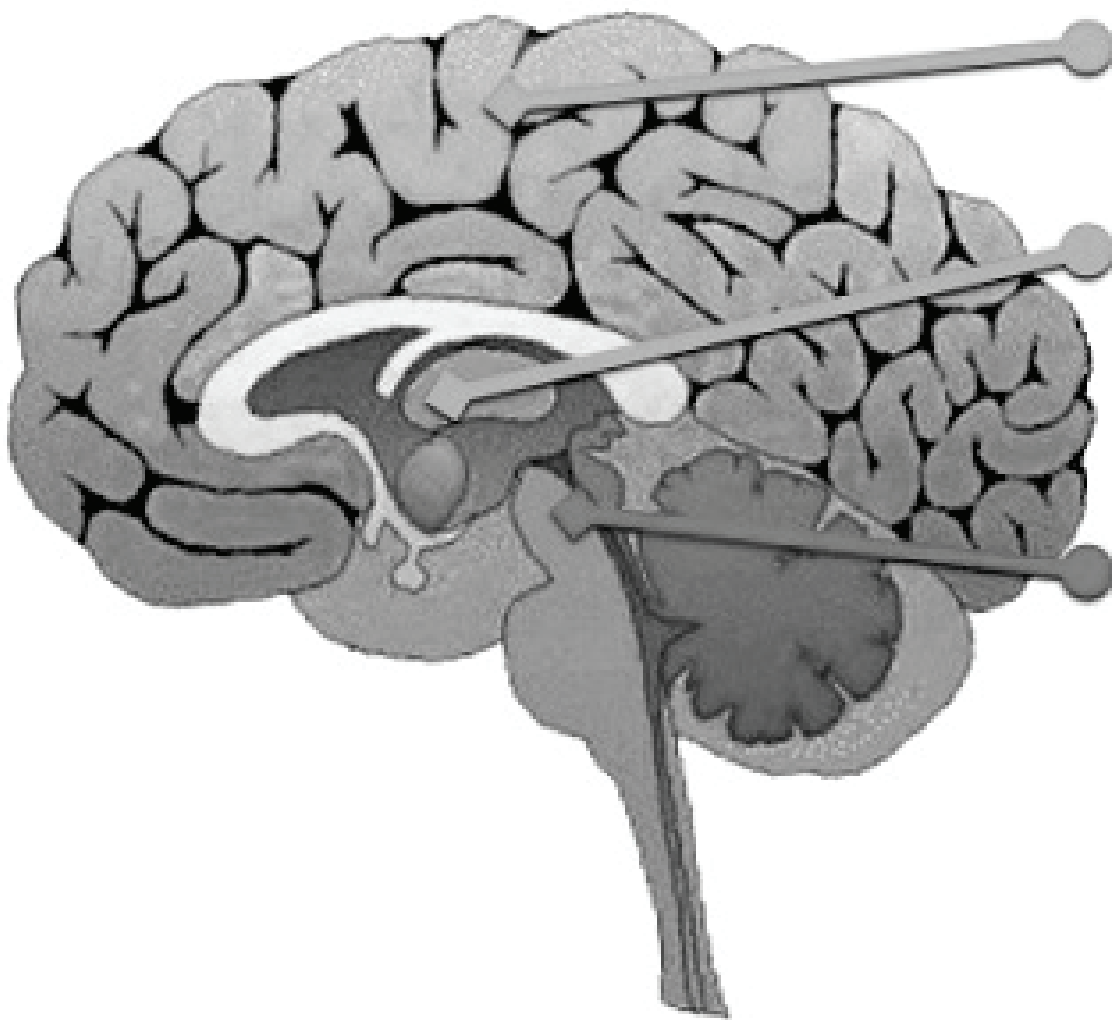

You Can't Be Successful

Unless You Control This One Thing First!

When it comes to success you will hear a lot of ideals about how you can achieve it. Some people believe you must envision it happening and it will (i.e. the law of attraction). Others will tell you that you must have a great plan or have set excellent goals. Others will say you must not give up and have a high level of will power. Still others will tell you, you must be action driven.

When looking at all these ideals they all have a ray or two of truth. But none of these is more important than the other. There is one thing that you must have before any of these things can consistently work for you. That one thing that you must have is called State Control.

State Control is the state of mind that your identity puts you in. Your Identity tells you who you think you are and what you think you are worth. So, if you think highly of yourself, then your State Control will be one of success. But, if you think little of yourself then State Control will not be in a place of success and no matter what you do to be successful it will usually fall short.

An example of this: Have you ever had someone trying to sell you something and he is telling you all about the benefits of the product and how good it is, but you see in him that he either doesn't believe in the product or himself. How many times did you buy that object?

Most of the time we didn't, unless we really, really wanted before he gave us the sales pitch.

What happened? The person that was selling you had bad State Control so when they tried to get you to sync with them you did, but not how they wanted you to. They wanted you to listen to their words, but you synced to their feelings of disbelief or doubt and it was louder and more persuasive than their words.

The problem is a lot of time what we consciously think of ourselves and what we unconsciously think of ourselves do not match. It all boils down to how our brain works. You see we have three brains: The Neo Cortex, Limbic System and The Reptilian Brain.

The youngest part of the brain is the Neo Cortex. It is responsible for such things as processing the written language, complex thinking, calculating, and rationalizing your decision. The Limbic System of the brain processes emotional responses. It gives you a gut feeling on your decision. The oldest part of the brain is the reptilian area. It is responsible for instinct and survival. Its main focus is to avoid pain. This area is what makes our decisions.

When we start to examine ourselves on the surface we usually do it through the lens of the Neo Cortex. It rationalizes our actions to the rest of the world why we do what we do, to make us acceptable. It will also at times determine who we are by the actions we take.

For example: If we procrastinate a few times, it may label us a procrastinator (an identity statement). So every time we go to do something of significance, our brain tells us since we are a procrastinator that is what we are going to do.

The truth is that the reason we put stuff off might not have anything to do with us being a procrastinator but because we have a fear of failure. Remember the Reptilian Brain is the decision maker and it would do everything it can to keep us from pain. In this circumstance, not doing the action keeps us safe through the Reptilian Brains lens.

How many of you have put something off that you know you should do but didn't do it and later justified it with calling yourself a procrastinator. So, we consciously set our State Control as a procrastinator, and when we go to achieve a goal or act, we sabotage ourselves.

To compound the situation, our Limbic System attaches a feeling to that belief and it intensifies the situation. For example, we don't do something and we get angry or disappointed in ourselves.

You see we start to confuse the things we do to who we are. A problem occurs if we think that we are dealing with the problem when it is only the symptom. If we get rid of the symptom, but not the problem, most of the time the symptom will come back.

Have you ever tried to lose weight and you did, only to have something happen in your life and you gained the weight back? The problem is not that you are overweight, the problem is that there is something under the surface that has you feeling that the weight is necessary. It could be a dramatic situation that happen in your life that the weight is protecting you from or making you feel that you deserve to be where you are.

To change your State Control, you must change the things that are holding you down in your identity. The key is identifying the true issues and then making the changes. Once you do that, then all

those things that you heard will help you be successful can now work in your life.

So, the million-dollar question is how do I make the changes in my identity so I can have great State Control? There is a series of things you can do to make the changes:

Identify the real problem

- Relabel the real problems and symptoms
- Reattribute the real problems and symptoms
- Refocus the real problems and symptoms
- Revalue the real problems and symptoms

In the next article, I will break down the above series and show you how to utilize them to create change. By the way, there is a quicker way to change and that is through hypnosis or NLP.

Proper Transport Security Can Keep Your Company Moving Forward

Recently the California Bureau of Marijuana Control has posted on its website the intent to establish very strict regulations and guidelines on how recreational and medical marijuana can be transported when packaged, and you can expect with the over regulations that California is known for, that your company could fall into serious violation(s) of State regulations if you fail to follow all laws to the letter.

The proposed regulations would also set the minimum age for drivers and passengers of licensed transport vehicles at 21 years of age and regulations

would enumerate the information and the qualifying events that must be entered into the track and trace system.

Currently companies have set their own individual standards on how they move marijuana based products business to business, and all too often these practices have resulted in confiscation by law enforcement entities, theft by organized criminals and loss from insider thefts, these transport practices result in the loss of hundreds of thousands of dollars each year for California based marijuana businesses and can be

Secondly, do your due diligence and ask that the security company provide you with its States license number, then go to governing website and to verify that the security license is in good standing, along with the State verification it would be a matter of good business practice to conduct your own social media background on the company to find out if the company your relying has a bad reputation in the security industry, the Better Business Bureau is a good source for such information.

Third if possible ask the security company for references, however in the cannabis industry you may find that most companies operate under strict non-disclosure agreements with marijuana related businesses and they will have to honor prior requests and be un-

able to provide a cannabis business for you to speak with.

Lastly see if you can speak to someone that is part of the company's ownership and have your questions and concerns addressed by a decision maker, inquire about the experience of its employees and the company's experience dealing with the canna industry and law enforcement. Don't leave your company's bottom line in limbo, by not obtaining the best available information directly from the top.

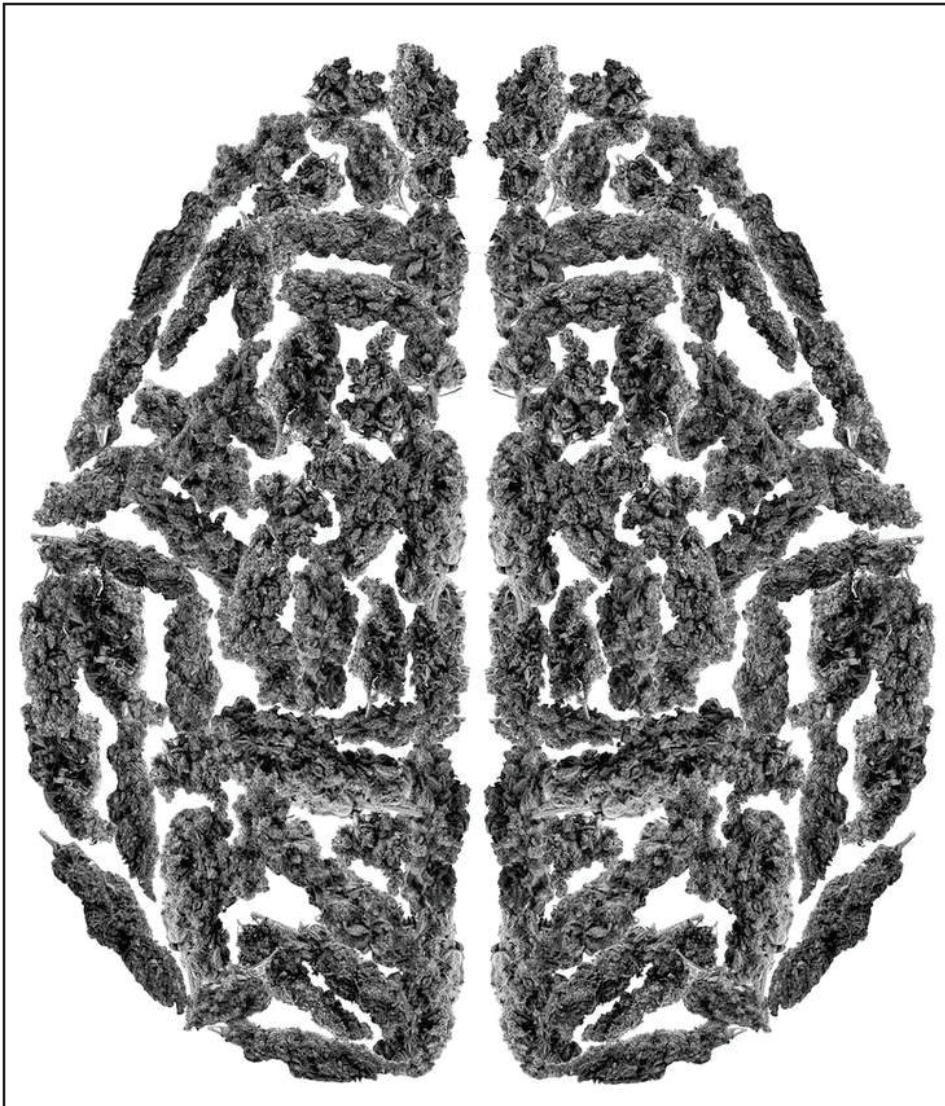

Cannabis and the Aging Brain

Astounding new experiments with both younger and mature mice have revealed that treatment with cannabis on aging people may be able to extend their brain health. The greatest reason for this, as determined by doctors and other scientists is that cannabis has demonstrated a protective effect on their brains. Though, in these cases, it is the THC compound in marijuana and not CBD as might have been expected.

At the University of Bonn in Germany, experiments showed that a small amount of THC injected into the brains of mice of different ages produced amazing results. These findings were initially reported on in *The Journal of Natural Medicine*. The first result that was observed was that when small amounts of THC were injected into the brains of older mice, the THC made their brains younger. The scientists found that the cannabis helped older mice retain cognitive abilities. Usually, these are the mental abilities that digress with age. They were also surprised to discover that younger mice brains were made older. These tests were conducted consistently over a period of four weeks. During this testing period, brains of these older mice were shown to have regressed to the mental state of a two month old mouse.

A neuroscientist named Andras Bilkei-Gorzo recently reported these results to the Voice of America (voa.com.) Many of the scientists involved then began to think about how these facts could help reduce the decline of the cognitive abilities in older people. As a result, there were a number of other scientists who began to make valid comments about this astounding research.

Dr. Gary Wenk, Ph.D. in the Department of Psychology at Ohio State University agrees. Dr. Wenk is also a Member of the Governor's Marijuana Advisory Committee. In a recent interview with Yahoo News, he stated that the results were nothing short of amazing. He stated that the evidence shows great promise regarding the cognitive and neurological benefits for aging brains. Dr. Wenk went on to clearly declare that THC appears to reduce brain inflammation. Therefore THC very positively affects the consequences of normal brain function as people age.

Researchers then examined the brains of the older, treated mice, seeking an explanation of how this might have happened. They discovered that the neurons in the hippocampus (the area critical for learning and memory) had sprouted more synaptic spines. The synaptic spines are the points of contact for communication between neurons.

Mark Ware, a clinical researcher at McGill University in Montreal made the following statement. "To anyone that studies the endocannabinoid system, these findings are not necessarily surprising... The reason I say that is because the system has homeostatic properties everywhere we look." This means that the results may vary depending on the situation. Ware continued, "the detrimental effects that are seen in younger brains with an abundance of cannabinoids, in older brains may turn out to be beneficial because they have a lack of cannabinoids."

CBN

CBN is somewhat psychoactive at roughly 10% the activity of THC. CBN is a breakdown product that occurs when THC is exposed to light or heat. CBN causes drowsiness and reduces spasms.

CBG

CBG, which is more commonly found in the non-psychoactive hemp plant, has shown significant ability to counteract and prevent tumor formation.

CBD

CBD is not psychoactive; studies have shown it to have anti-inflammatory, anti-anxiety, anti-nausea, neuroprotective, blood pressure lowering and pain-killing properties, among many others.

THC

The most well-known cannabinoid and the most psychoactive. THC has the ability to alter behavior, mood perception and consciousness. THC is responsible for the euphoric feeling some people consider as being "high."

THCV

THCV is a psychoactive cannabinoid that may help treat diabetes and is being investigated as an anti obesity drug.

CBC

CBC has analgesic, anti inflammatory and very promising antibiotic properties.

Interview with Shez So Waxy Goodies

Kathleen McLean sat with the SD born-and-raised owner of Shez So Waxy Goodies, a medicated juice, canna lean, and candy company.

Kathleen: Is your brand known for edibles and juices?

Shez So Waxy: Yes, but mostly juices.

K: Do you go to all the local seshes and sell there?

SSW: They try to go to every possible event but, if they can't make it they send their edibles/juices with other people as giveaways.

K: How long have you been in the industry?

SSW: The business since 2015. But, in the industry for the past 5-6 years?

K: How did you start out in industry?

SSW: I started as a promo model and became a 420 model.

K: Are you still a 420 nurse?

SSW: Yes for a year and half i was the San Diego chapter leader but, stepped down in the past year to focus on my business and became a 420 nurse.

K: Is this your only business, do you have a background in baking, cooking?

SSW: Yes, I started as a teenager bak-

ing cakes with my grandmother for weddings, birthdays and special events. We did five and six tier cakes. I for sure have a background in baking.

K: What do you think about the government regulating edibles and kitchen locations?

SSW: I'm not for the government stepping in.

K: Who is your biggest competitor?

SSW: Myself, I don't worry about what other people are making. There's room for everyone. I battle with myself, the way the edibles are made and making sure they taste good.

K: One concern we have as consumers is where the food is made, how do you combat that?

SSW: We have videos on social media of us baking so the consumer can see where we are baking and see the area is clean. We use gloves, the hair is back and we make sure to be transparent to show the process. Our kitchen stays clean at all times.

K: Tell me a little about your presentation?

SSW: Presentation is everything. We have our labeling on all of our jars. When we have juices for the patients to sample it's in a CLOSED container with a spout at the bottom.

K: Can you tell me more about the juices, what would you say for someone with a low tolerance for THC, how much would I drink?

SSW: Out of an 8oz, I would only sug-

gest drinking 4oz at a time. Our juices are powered by rozin tincture like a liquid dab. We also infuse it with Keif,

K: What's Keif?

SSW: It's basically trichomes, crystals that break off the flowers and it's sifted through the screens. We decarb the flower, we decarb the keif, because if you don't decarb it you'll get more of a CBD high. Adding keif to an edible or drink makes it more potent.

K: What is decarb?

SSW: I put the weed in the oven at 100 degrees for an hour. Everyone de-carbs a little different but, I find decarbing at 100 degrees is best.

K: What is a good question I as a consumer would ask someone selling edibles?

SSW: "What's your decarb process?"

K: What's a bad answer, a red flag for us to listen for?

SSW: If they decarb at more than 200 degrees. One company I asked and they decarbed at 300 degrees which, lessens the THC potency.

K: Does your family know you make edibles and do they judge you for it?

SSW: My whole family knows and they are all very supportive of it. My grandmother even knew, she enjoyed flowers because it helped with her aches and pains.

K: I'm a mom and I'm pro marijuana but, I know for me there's still a stigma with being a mother that consumes THC. Do you feel the pressure?

SSW: Yes I honestly do. Sometimes I still feel like I have to be careful. It's scary to have out. When we are done we make sure to put everything away and high up.

K: How do you think you'll be when your daughter gets older?

SSW: I'll be open about it. When people joke about mommy wants a glass of wine, it should be as socially acceptable to say Mommy wants a joint. I lost my first born and smoking marijuana definitely helped me get through that. It calms me down and helps with my anxiety.

K: Do you feel like other mothers would benefit from medicating?

SSW: Yes for sure yes. My house, like other homes gets a little crazy, between the talking, the T.V and the baby there's always something going on. I can medicate and just chill, get the dishes done, get the household jobs done and be so calm about it.

K: Thank you for bringing gifts, can you please explain a little about each one?

SSW: We have cinnamon toast terps, this is infused with coconut oil with rozin chips. The juices are 150mg and infused with medicine rozin and keif. We try and give our patients more quantity for their money.

K: How do you feel about the patients?

SSW: It's all about the patients. We want to get them great products at low prices. We have a few patients that we know are struggling and spend most of their money on transportation. We always hook them up. We ultimately want to be the best for our patients. We do all types of specials, buy one get one, among others. We change our specials to meet the need of the individual patient.

K: Other than seshes where do you sell your products?

SSW: We have a delivery service and cater to all over San Diego county. Peo-

Chula Vista City Council Meeting

The Chula Vista City Council Ostrich

The city of Chula Vista has unanimously voted to ban all marijuana dispensaries medical and recreational. The council doesn't feel like they have had enough time to come up with regulations, which is odd seeing medical marijuana has been approved in the state of California since 1996. This leaves most citizens to question how much more time they need? One resident stood up and addressed the city council comparing

them to Ostriches, sticking their heads in the sand to ignore what's going on.

The city for now, will not have any approved dispensaries until they come up with a long term policy on the collectives. One of the members did stress at the close of the meeting that they do just see this as being temporary and they will address the issue at a future date.

The other cannabis related item on the agenda had addressed adding marijuana and other controlled substances to their social host ordinance. The social host ordinance is by definition, a legal term of the law that deals with the liability of a person who supplies liquor

to a guest under the legal age. Under current social host ordinance laws, the host shares any liability incurred as a result of actions by an intoxicated guest to whom he or she has served liquor.

The city says they will be cracking down on the social host ordinance holding adults responsible for providing access to minors. Chula Vista Police Captain Lon Turner was quoted by CBS 8 as saying these parties have date rapes happening and all kinds of other disorderly behavior. If the city adds marijuana to the proposed social host ordinance it would read like this

"It is the duty of any person having control of any premises, who knowingly hosts, permits, or allows a gathering at said premises to take all reasonable steps to prevent the consumption of alcoholic beverages, marijuana, or other controlled substances by any minor at the gathering."

Vista Commissions Dispensary Poll

For the past few months, the Vista City Council has been under increasing pressure to come up with a solution to the city's dispensary zoning problem. With the reality of voter-approved recreational marijuana in California, and new state medical cannabis regulations coming in 2018, the city is being forced to make a decision about something they can no longer try to fix with police raids and asset forfeiture.

In February, local citizen group Vistans for Better Community Access (VBCA) submitted an initiative that would set up a local licensing and regulation system for medical marijuana outlets, but the Vista City Clerk rejected it after discovering that the title of the proposal was missing from some pages. California election law requires each page to bear the title of the initiative that a person is signing. The group submitted nearly 1,400 more signatures than the required 5,600, but because of the erroneous pages, much of the initiative was invalidated and ultimately rejected. The proposal would have allowed for the operation of at least ten dispensaries in Vista and implemented a 7% tax rate on sales. With close to 100,000 residents in the city, there would be about one dispensary per 10,000 people.

VBCA is currently gathering new signatures for the initiative, but the council is not satisfied with its terms. They are currently working on their own city-drafted ordinance which allows for the licensing and operation of just two dispensaries in Vista, or one per 50,000 residents. Under their proposal, the city would also get to select the two medical marijuana providers. If the VCBA initiative gathers enough signatures, a special election may be held.

In an attempt to get a better idea of residents' feelings on the matter, the city council is commissioning a \$35,000 poll to be conducted by an independent outside company. At a meeting in

late April, council members discussed polling locals, then at a May 9 session, they decided to go ahead with the survey. Councilman Joe Green was absent that evening, but other members in attendance voted 3-1 to pay for the study. Amanda Rigby voted against the poll, uncomfortable with the possibility of licensing something that is currently illegal at the federal level.

But fears of intervention from on high would appear to be unwarranted at this point. The federal government isn't allocating financial resources to keeping medical marijuana states in-line with their policies anymore. Without funding, the federal raids just aren't going to happen. Local governments are the only ones doing that kind of thing now. There is currently an attorney general in office who is a vocal opponent of cannabis, but he answers directly to a President who believes in state rights for medical marijuana, so it is unlikely to see any action against medical states from federal agencies in the near future, if at all. Additionally, a bipartisan group of congressmen introduced HR 1227, the Ending Federal Marijuana Prohibition Act of 2017, earlier this year. If the bill passes, it will eliminate penalties for cannabis possession and cultivation as well as give states the power to create their own marijuana policies without fear of federal intervention.

Given the current state of things in Washington D.C., the city of Vista should have very little to worry about when it comes to Uncle Sam meddling in local medical marijuana affairs. Council members have commissioned a poll that will tell them what their residents think. If their proposal is the one that ends up being enacted instead of VCBA's, they will need to ensure that the rules are fair to all those involved and meet the needs of the patients. Otherwise, the pointless legal battles will continue until a proper agreement can be reached or the council is replaced.

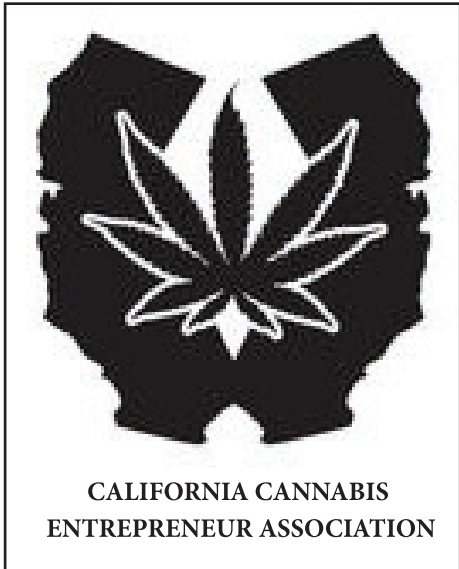


