First Time Grower

Growing your own cannabis is easier today than it has ever been. There is a wealth of information out there that can help aid you in the process. I recently moved to San Diego, and one of my goals was to learn horticulture to grow my own cannabis. Trust me when I say I am no expert. If you do your research and follow directions, it's a relatively easy process. As a first time grower, here are a few things you may want to consider before you begin your horticulture journey.

One of the first things to consider is where you are going to grow. This is an important decision because where you grow impacts the yield of the plant. Are you going to grow indoors or outdoors? What's your budget? How much space will you need for your grow? Are you going to set up more than one tent? Do you want to do a traditional soil grow? Conversely, do you want to do a hydroponic setup? These questions serve as a baseline for your grow but ultimately depend on your preference as a first-time grower.

Once you have selected where you want to grow, you will then want to decide the method of how you're are going to grow. The Internet serves as an excellent resource differentiating traditional soil grows, and deep water culture or a hydroponic. As a first timer, there can be information overload as to which route to take. I found most of my intormation at growweedeasy.com. This is one of the best informational sources out there in my opinion. This site breaks down these options for a novice, like myself, to better understand what was best for my situation. I was able to educate myself on everything I needed for my grow for a successful start. This site provided great insights that I had not previously considered. For example, will the area have access to fresh air? It highlighted the pros and cons of each method, some of which had not crossed my mind. The site referenced some great stuff on there. I highly recommend it.

I'll explain which route I took and why, and provide some examples of where to find the information. Growing can be financially straining. The acquisition of materials can be costly. Having a growing partner has its financial benefits. Lastly, what better bonding experience is there than to grow weed with a trustworthy friend to learn and grow with? In my opinion, this is a solid start to a successful grow. Winning all around!

You are probably wondering which route I took and why. Let me explain. We decided to do a hydroponic grow. We wanted to get a high yield but were limited with space. Many of us face this issue in small apartments. Networking with friends to see what materials you can borrow is beneficial as well. We were able to acquire pieces of equipment through friends. This alleviated the cost of buying other equipment that was necessary for our grow.

Like I said it's all about preference and this method made the most sense for us. There was a sale at San Diego Hydro, where we were able to purchase what we needed at a great price. If you are local to the San Diego area, I would check these guys out. The staff was very knowledgeable and helpful and gave some great advice. We were going to use clear tubing in our hydro set up, and a guy suggested that we use solid tubing to avoid algae build up. Whether you have specific questions on your grow or you are a novice just entering the industry, San Diego Hydro is an excellent opportunity to speak with someone in person and walk away with tons knowledge setting you up for success.

Do you want a kit or do you want to purchase each part individually? You can easily find a kit online; it will have everything you need, and you don't need to worry about compatibility. You can Google "grow kit", or check good ol' Amazon. However, this will probably cost a lot of money. Do not be fooled by price tags. A higher price tag of a product does not yield a more profitable product. In my experience, the cheaper products often times work just as well. I would lean toward researching what you need and acquiring the pieces individually. I think this is a good place



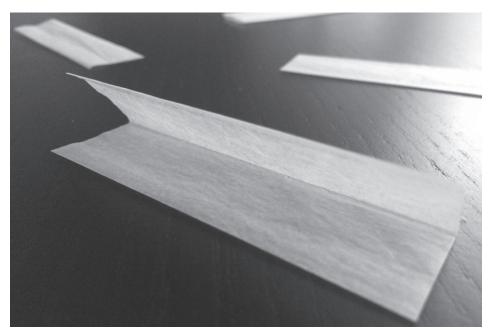

History of Rolling Papers

The technology of smoking continues to advance with vapes and pens; many people continue to love good, old rolling papers. People have likely been rolling things up in paper and smoking them since the creation of paper in the 1100's. However, papers made specifically for rolling are concretely linked to being created in 15th century Spain.

Peasants in 15th century Spain used to pick up discarded cigars, cut them open, and re-roll them with newspaper scraps. The cigars that the peasants were finding were brought to Spain by Christopher Columbus's crew. When Columbus and his crew returned to Spain from an excursion, they were smoking tobacco rolled up in tobacco and palm leaves. These were early cigars and caught on quickly with wealthy people.

While smoking a cigar, the tobacco tar builds up inside the cigar, "turning" it or making it taste bad. Naturally, when a smoker's cigar turned, they would toss it in the street. This is when the peasants would come in, scooping up the cigars to harvest what was left. The newspapers that these peasants were smoking were printed with ink that contained lead, cadmium, and surely some other harmful chemicals.

Papermakers noted how disgusting it

was that peasants were smoking repurposed litter. To be candid, they likely didn't care about the cleanliness of the matter but rather saw an opportunity to make money. So, paper mills started making rolling papers. They used processed white paper and marketed the rolling papers as hygienic.

You really could cut out a piece of The Candid Chronicle and rolled a joint with it. It might not be the best joint, but it would be nothing compared to the 15th-century newspaper cigarettes that these peasants were twisting up. The Candid Chronicle is printed with soy based ink.

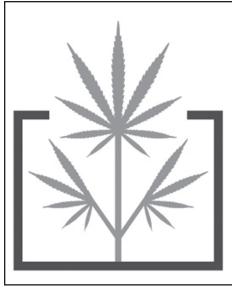
Originally, rolling papers were created in large sheets. You'd simply cut off whatever piece you needed. As time went on, pre-cut rolling papers became popular and cut down on preparation time for the consumer. The first rolling paper booklet was created by a Dominican monk to protect the papers. The booklets eventually made it to Alcoy, Spain where they were reproduced.

Now, there is a wide variety of rolling paper options. Transparent cellulose papers, fruit flavored, 24k edible gold papers, hemp papers, pre-rolled cones, and papers of all sizes. It's amazing what ingenuity can blossom from a little trash picking.

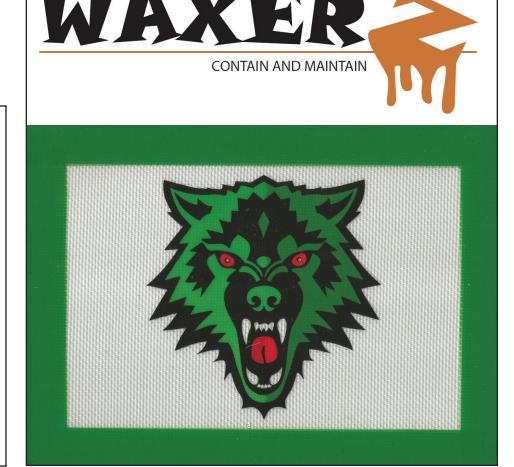

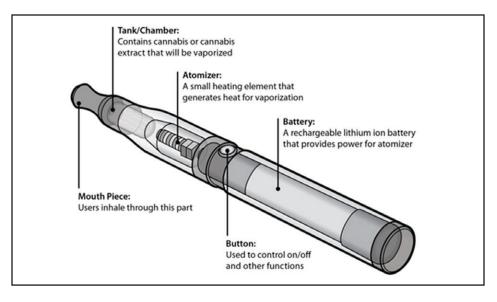

Vape Pens... Love 'Em?

This article is a tad bit challenging as there has been very little research done on vape pens. Due to the lack of studies, there's no real way anyone could responsibly report the long-term effects of smoking marijuana out of a vape pen compared to a blunt, joint, pipe, or bong. There are, however, hypotheses based on suggestions and popular beliefs. For example, most reports suggest marijuana is "safer" than smoking cigarettes, but there haven't been enough long-term studies completed to come to a definite conclusion. Shortterm studies (60 days or less), done on habitual marijuana smokers showed increased lung health when a person switched from smoking a joint to smoking a vape pen. Participants claimed to have stopped coughing up phlegm and were breathing more clearly than when smoking blunts, joints, pipes, or bongs daily.

Vape pens give people the freedom of smoking marijuana anywhere without engulfing yourself and the people around you in burning weed. The smoke that comes from a vape pen is a more clean, white smoke with much less odor. Vape pens are great for someone on the go. When I go to a bar, event, or nightclub, I can conveniently take a hit off the vape pen without tons of people looking around and asking me for a hit. It's not that I don't like sharing but, when I'm trying to be discreet, and people are asking if they can get in on my blunt, damn it, they blow my cover. Because I'm not a famous rapper or even an Instagram bathroom model, I don't have the freedom of walking around the nightclub without getting blown. Discretion is entirely necessary, and vape pens come through every time.

Did I mention vape cartridges are also way cheaper than buying flowers? I would consider myself a habitual marijuana smoker. I smoke on average two times per day, seven days per week. I wouldn't say I'm a loner stoner, so it's accurate to say I go through about a half ounce per week, which is approximately \$100-\$125 per week on marijuana. The cartridge that contains pure THC and goes into a vape pen only cost \$25. I could go through a max two of those per week, while some weeks it's just one. Using vape pens make it a lot easier for me to stop smoking once I achieve the desired effect, instead of smoking a whole blunt.

It seems as though a major con to smoking a vape pen is they can explode due to their lithium-ion batteries. From my research, I have surmised that lithium-ion batteries have a strict operating window that people would want to adhere to. Whether it's a hoverboard or a vape pen, these batteries have a small window in which they should operate. The batteries are best kept between 50 and 115 degrees Fahrenheit. These temperatures workout perfect for us San Diegans because our temperature averages 70 degrees. However, in the winter, 90% of the United States will get colder than a mere 50 degrees. I would advise people to learn more about the brand they are buying and to adhere to the warnings of vape pens.

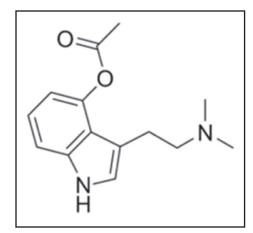

Don't Spice Up Your Life

We are currently seeing an explosion of new drugs, or research chemicals, which are being mass produced all over the world. Research chemicals are, for the most part, a crafty way for people to catch a specific high without having to fear prosecution for possessing a controlled substance. Most people in the medical marijuana community are familiar with synthetic cannabinoids sold as "spice" or "potpouri" at head shops. The purpose of synthetic cannabis is simply to provide the user with a THC-like high. Unfortunately, there are people who, due to lack of safe access, or simply due to ignorance, ingest synthetic cannabis thinking it is as safe to use as the real thing.

Unlike traditional cannabis, "spice" has proven to cause many physical issues which can eventually lead to very severe physical addiction. While cannabis (along with chocolate, pho, cuddling, tacos, and just about anything that feels good) can become psychologically addicting, there is never an actual danger for severe physical withdrawals, which are present with harder drugs such as opiates. A severe case of drug withdrawals is a complete shock to the system which can, unfortunately, lead to death in the worst of cases.

It is truly a shame that our government has created a culture where people fear persecution from law enforcement and their peers, to the point where they are willing to take a technically unknown chemical to reach a high. While all drugs will eventually have some negative effect on your body, we have years and years of research on the traditional drugs, and therefore can perfectly predict our personal outcome if we continue to abuse the drug. With research chemicals, we truly are taking a guess, as most of these drugs are being created and then slightly modified, in order to avoid falling into illegal standing with the DEA or other drug enforcement agencies. There is currently a Federal Analogue Act that aims to make all research chemicals illegal, but we are yet to see their plan make a dent in the markets.

The current marketplace for research chemicals and just about any other drug is quickly moving towards the darknet. The darknet is essentially a heavily encrypted "internet", while it is accessed through a regular internet connection. There are specific prerequisites needed

to enter the sites. The darknet has become a way for people to not only sell drugs, but also trade information. In many parts of the world where internet access is extremely controlled by the government, such as North Korea, and other dictatorship countries. This is the only way people can gather information from outside of their country, or to communicate with outside sources. Most of the daily life accounts we have from countries such as North Korea or Syria (before the fall), has been filtered out through the darknets, something that would have been impossible to do only a decade ago.

With private companies and good citizen coders being miles ahead of the government's efforts to crack down. Darknet markets have a promising future, especially with bitcoins and other crypto-currencies taking hold all over the globe. While it is fantastic to see an open source currency and open source market offer true anonymity to both sellers and buyers, it does create an interesting supply chain in the current drug world. With the darknet offering extremely cheap research chemicals being mass produced in China, we are seeing many street dealers selling illegitimate chemicals to their clientele since they produce a similar effect. Please remember, always test your drugs before ingesting them.

While the concept of a darknet might sound a bit chaotic and threatening, it does offer freedom of speech to those who have never known it. But most importantly it has offered a way for Psychonauts and other drug enthusiasts to explore new drugs that are becoming part of the "traditional" drug culture. Being able to share experiences with new substances without fear of incrimination has allowed for clandestine research of these new chemicals. Thanks to the darknet we are seeing an explosion of psychedelics such as 2C-B and 4-ACO-DMT along with many of their analogues.

2C-B has been around since the mid 70's but it has not been until recent years that we have seen an explosion of 2C-B use. With the easy availability of the drug, people can share their research and we can find a safe way to use the chemical. 2C-B is described by many as the love child of alcohol, LSD, and MDMA.

Most people describe the onset of the effects to be felt about 45 minutes after oral ingestion of the chemical. The initial effects are similar to MDMA in the way that skin sensitivity and tactile feelings are extremely enhanced. There is then a very present uplifting mood enhancement which occurs, many people relate this to the social lubrication brought on by alcohol. Lastly, the psychedelic visuals begin to propagate themselves, a special shimmer and meltiness to textures can be seen all over, depending on dosage amounts the visuals can range from slight to overwhelming.

Effects usually last about 6 hours, with a peak around the second hour, the drug

can be re-dosed without any buildup of tolerance, like LSD would have. Also, the drug does not cause the "headspace" which would be felt on a traditional Psychedelic, it is very difficult to have a negative trip on the substance. The drug has not proven to be neurotoxic such as MDMA can be. While the chemical has been around for decades, the darknets have put the chemical in the hands of more people allowing for more research. This has all ultimately lead to safer use of the chemical.

4-ACO-DMT is another very popular up and coming research chemical which has been around since the early 60's. It came from the same company which brought us LSD, Sandoz Ltd. Labs. Albert Hoffman who we can thank for LSD was also involved in the first synthesization of 4-ACO-DMT. This chemical has been described by many as a true substitute for Psychedelic Mushrooms as the chemical is processed into Psilocin by our system, which many of us are familiar with thanks to Psilocybin mushrooms.

The administration of this chemical is also usually through oral form. The chemical takes about 45 minutes to take effect with a peak being felt around 90 minutes into the experience. The effects of the drug are described to mirror those of the familiar Psilocybin mushroom, this means the usual body dopiness and intricate Mayan-like fractals that fill the vision. Unlike 2C-B, 4-ACO-DMT acts as a traditional psychedelic in the sense that it offers a heavy "headspace" which can be deeply altered by the mindset of the user and their physical setting. Some users, however, report that there is a bit of a heavier body load feeling while on the drug, compared to a traditional Psychedelic such as LSD or Mushrooms. Additionally, there is a constant fluctuation of body temperature which can lead to discomfort in inexperienced users. Once again, this is all information which can be backed up by users research thanks to the availability, and anonymity offered by darknets. This information share is something that would have been impossible not too long ago.

All in all, we must understand that we live in a constantly changing world. Every aspect of our environment be it physical or spiritual is in constant fluctuation. The state of the drug world must be carefully watched by those involved within, as it is very easy to get caught up in the wrong crowd with the wrong chemical. Please do your research when looking into trying a new drug, don't believe that these new alternatives will give you the desired high without any consequence. Just because they are "legal highs", does not mean they are good for you. Most of the times you will find that it is preferable to stick to the traditional drugs, but there is definitely room for the some new chemicals to bring something new to the table.

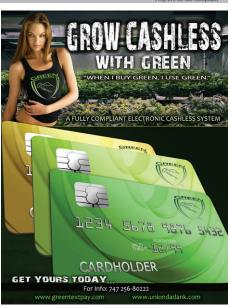

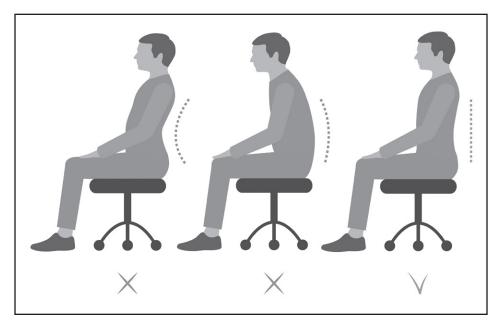

Bad Posture and an Orange Shirt

Alignment beats everything. get about what you were told about good posture. Telling people to sit up straight has only made things worse. I typically follow the philosophy of Gray Cook, a physical therapist who created the FMS, which is "first move well and then move often." But with a lot of my clients, I would like to take it a step further and tell you to sit well first and stand well first. There are traditional societies out there today who do not have back pain, or any chronic pain for that matter. They sit differently, they stand differently, and they move differently than we do here in this cul-

ture. Esther Gokhale is a woman who lives now in California and has developed the Gokhale method for treating pain. She developed debilitating back pain and was on a quest to find the root cause of back pain. She traveled to parts of the world to live among people in cultures who do not have chronic pain but who do perform physical labor and in fact sit for different types of work. She lived in Burkina Faso, rural parts of Portugal and also fishing villages in Brazil. Her insights helped her develop a step by step guide to help people suffering from back pain, but more than that has transformed what we know as good posture.

In this culture, over the years we have developed very poor sitting and standing posture. Gokhale believes that the changes started in the 1920's as the fashion industry took hold. A slouched, relaxed posture became vogue, and even furniture started to change to accommodate a slouched relaxed sitting posture. If you notice paintings or photographs taken prior to the 1920's in America, you will notice a much different sitting posture.

We typically tell our kids to "sit up straight" so they sit straight for a short time into a very upright rigid, tense position which becomes very uncomfortable, so they return to slouching. Furthermore, children are programmed to take their cues from the adults around them. In other words, they already learned their poor posture from watching you. They USED to have good posture when they were toddlers but then took on the postural habits that their parents have (and were also then put in a chair in school to be bored to death for hours at a stretch).

I've been working in the healthcare field for 20 years, and I can assure you that collectively we have not done a very good job with understanding posture although it does seem to be turning around. We took the average poor posture and called it normal. It's not. Most of our car seats, lumbar support cushions and even the braces that we use for people with back pain exacerbate our misalignment by increasing the curvature in the upper lumbar spine and flattening the natural lumbo-sacral curve (in the lower lumbar spine) as well as forcing our heads into a forward position.

As you can see with orange shirt guy (why an orange shirt with green pants?) in the picture in the middle he is relaxed and slumped in a c-shape which is how a lot of us sit. Our butts are tucked under us. In the picture on the far left, he is arched and tense, overcorrecting and trying to "sit up straight." He ends up flaring his ribs and exaggerating the curve in his back. Esther Gokhale has found that the pain-free societies tend to sit like the picture on the far right which is more of a taller, lengthened spine. The pelvis is slightly rotated forward and more importantly the ribs are flush with the abdomen vs. being flared up or down.

Another way to look at the ribs from the side view is to see them in the shape of a bell as explained by Julie Wieb, another posture therapist. The picture on the far left shows "bell rung up" and the picture in the middle shows "bell rung down". Ultimately, you should be able to eventually relax into a tall, lengthened position (orange shirt far right) without exaggerated curves in sitting or standing. It does take some getting used to but I've seen great results with people who decide to work on improving their posture. There are other things to think about with posture but the pelvis and ribs are a good place to

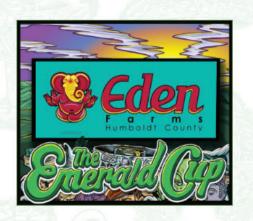

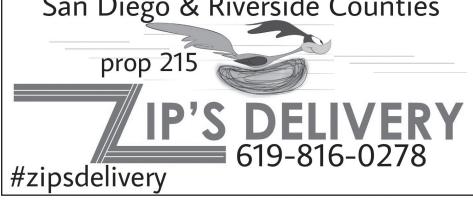

And I heard him exclaim as he toked and pulled the Cannabus out of sight, "HEMPY Hashmas to all and to all a good flight!!!"

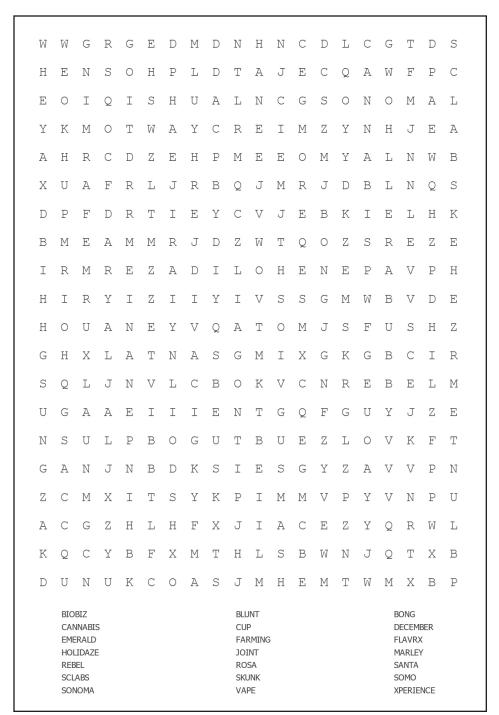

Cannabis Coconut Oil

Put the Weed in the Coconut

The first and hardest step to cooking with cannabis is to make the oil or butter. When heated with butter/oil the THC in weed activates and binds to the fat, thus infusing the butter/oil with THC. Traditionally, we hear about weed butter but when it comes to which fat to use, go for coconut oil. Since coconut oil has a higher quantity of saturated fats than butter and olive oil, more THC can be absorbed.

You can substitute your cannabis infused coconut oil into any recipe calling for coconut oil or butter. Substituting coconut oil for butter is a 1 to 1 ratio.

Ingredients:

- 1 cup of virgin coconut oil
- ¼ ounce of cannabis

Directions:

- 1. Preheat oven to 290°F.
- 2. Grind the weed finely to create more surface area and extract the most THC.

- 3. Decarb (or decarboxylate) your weed. This step is sensitive, so keep an eye on your weed to make sure it doesn't burn. Basically, you're toasting the weed to heat activate it. Put your weed on a pan or in a tinfoil pouch and then pop it in the oven for 7 minutes. Don't burn it!
- 4. Take the toasted out, and turn oven down to 250°F. Give it some time to cool down.
- 5. While the oven is cooling off, melt the coconut oil in the microwave.
- 6. Mix your decarbed/toasted weed with the melted coconut oil in an oven safe dish. Cover with foil and put in the oven for 60 minutes.
- 7. After 60 minutes, remove the dish and let cool for a few minutes. Filter out the weed bits with a strainer, coffee filter, or cheesecloth. You can use the oil as is or let it solidify in the fridge.

Note: Make your cannabis coconut oil as potent as you'd like! The amount of cannabis I listed is merely a suggestion.

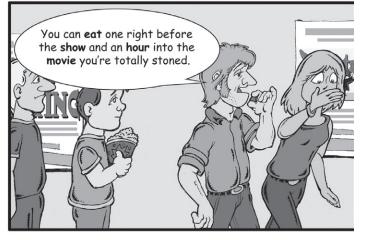

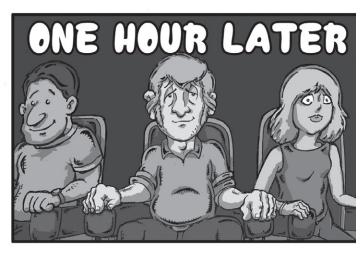

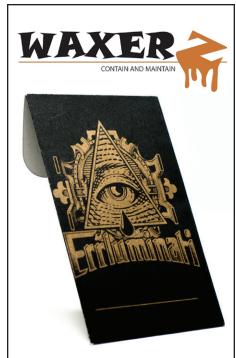
